- Tuesdays, 11:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.

- Students are expected to practice their music on their own.

Deadlines

Early Registration ends August 3.

A deposit of \$15.00 per student is required to complete registration. The remaining balance is due August 10. This will allow us to pre-order music and determine the needs of each choir.

Late Registration ends August 10 (first day of classes) unless previous arrangements have been made.

Full Tuition Due August 10 (first day of classes) unless previous arrangements have been made.

Unpaid account balances will result in the student being dropped from the class.

Family Discount

Families with more than two children involved in the choir are eligible for a \$10.00 discount for the 3rd, 4th and beyond enrolled student.

Choir Expectations

- PSCA Choirs provide a safe, loving, disciplined, creative, educational and Christian environment where students can learn to develop a sense of community where faith and integrity are upheld.
- Choir rehearsals will include instruction in music theory and music history.
- Music selection will include music of various styles, forms and periods.
- Choir rehearsals will be conducted in an orderly fashion. You can expect to work hard and enjoy yourself.
- It is the student's responsibility to bring their music and a pencil to each rehearsal.
- Use only pencil when marking music. No ink pens, please.
- No food or drinks allowed in the rehearsal room, except for water.
- Please avoid unnecessary distractions during rehearsal time, especially walking out during a rehearsal.
- Roll will be taken at the beginning of each class.
- Being a participant in any of the PSCA groups or lessons does not mean you are obligated to be a member of or to support Peoples Church. Our hope is that the education and training you receive here will be a blessing to your own church and community. We are always praying that God will open doors for us everywhere to be lights set on a hill. As a member of PSCA Choirs, you are encouraged to be involved in as many opportunities as reasonable for your family. Only the concert at the end of each semester is required.

Concert Attire

Concert attire is purchased by Peoples School of Creative Arts and will be housed on the premises. PSCA will be solely responsible for care, upkeep and distribution of these outfits

Parental Involvement

The choirs need help in specific areas. Please choose one or more that you would be willing to be involved in.

Class Assistant: Duties include some of the following: take roll, prepare and hand out name tags, distribute and put away music for your class, help with getting children on and off stage for performances, etc.

Concert Program: Prepare and/or distribute programs at concerts.

Concert Usher: Take offering during concerts.

Refreshments: Bring refreshments to celebrate birthdays once a month and for after concerts.

Transportation: Help organize movement to and from events.

Event Coordinator: Look for opportunities of community involvement and be the person with all the information for events (rest homes,

Peace Officers Memorial, festivals, etc.)

Fundraising: Help with fundraising for extra events.

Choir Historian: Take pictures and chronicle the stories of each year.

Grounds Monitor: Monitor sound and behavior in and outside the building, including bathrooms.

Concert Outfits: Help size, distribute and maintain concert clothing.

Concert Help: Help with various needs the night of the concert. Keeping choirs quiet while not onstage, passing out bow ties, vests, etc., collecting outfits after the concert.
